# Academic Reinforcement & Enhancement Initiative 2023-2024

- Students were identified through NJSLA data, IXL/iReady Diagnostics, F&P data
- These are students who were on the bubble of passing NJSLA last spring.
- NJSLA is particularly important for Absecon students due to HS options, career pathways, etc.
- Students are on or above grade level in at least some, but not all, of the domains of Math and/or ELA, which kept them from passing NJSLA

# Academic Reinforcement & Enhancement Initiative 2023-2024

- Reinforcement Team has identified the areas that need reinforcement and/or enhancement and has created a plan specifically for each student
- Between Nov 13-May (3 windows), students will be met with a team member for reinforcement/enhancement
  - Based on identified areas, students may cycle in and out of the program
    - Data driven, specific to each student, reinforced through certified Math/ELA staff through best practices

#### Roof Leak unrelated to Flashing on November 22


- Both Nurses Offices
