

Current Attales Schedule vs Potential COVID Closure Schedule

In addition to the video “*Current Attales Schedule vs Possible COVID Closure Schedule*” that was released on 12/2/20, below is a quick reference chart explaining how a possible COVID-19 school closure could impact existing schedules for Attales students. As you’ll see below, our current schedule allows for a relatively seamless transition from our existing in-person/hybrid/all virtual schedule to a potential COVID closure/all remote schedule.

These times would be similar to our regular schedule.</i>
5th & <u>Ms. Caputo</u>	All Virtual Program	*Synchronous online classes in the 3 core areas of Math, ELA, and Science or Social Studies 5 days per week done remotely via Google Meet. *Special areas done asynchronously and virtually via Google Classroom	No change
6th 7th 8th & <u>Mrs. Irwin</u>	Hybrid Program	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mon/Tues Cohort</u></p> *In-Person classes Mon/Tues *Synchronous remote Google Meet classes Weds/Thurs/Fri. *Special areas done asynchronously and virtually via Google Classroom <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Weds/Thurs Cohort</u></p> *In-Person classes Weds/Thurs *Synchronous remote Google Meet classes Mon/Tues/Fri. *Special areas done asynchronously and virtually via Google Classroom	If we are required to transition to an “All Remote” schedule for any reason, the only change is that all “in-person” classes convert to synchronous Google Meet classes done remotely and that follow our existing class meeting times. This means that classes meet at the same time every day regardless of whether our school is open or closed down for whatever reason. The only thing that changes is whether a student is attending class “in-person” or logging on to a Google Meet at your regularly scheduled class time. <i>NOTE: In this closure scenario, both Hybrid cohorts of High Ability students would be able to log on to the same Google Meet at the same time since we would no longer need to worry about class size in the virtual environment/Google Meet</i>
