

## **SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAM**

Following an absence from school for a communicable disease, or for hospitalization for any reason, a physician's note is required for re-admission to school.

Please do not send children to school when they have any of the following symptoms.

Fever	Diarrhea	Sore/Infected Throat
Nausea	Head Lice (nits)	Scabies (Untreated)
Untreated Cough	Cold	Swollen/Inflamed Eyes
Skin Rash	Tonsillitis	Contagious Diseases

Keep your child home at least one full day after fever or vomiting.

Infections being treated with antibiotics require a child to be taking the antibiotic one full day (24 hours) before returning to school.

The School health Office gives emergency first aid for school-related injuries or school time illnesses only. Find a relative, neighbor or friend for your child in case of emergency. Sick or injured children must be cared for at home. The school does not have an infirmary or a clinic.
